

Below are your tasks that are expected to be completed and collated in on folder of work. Students are not required to print any of these sheets, but will need to view them to see the tasks they need to complete.

In Year 8 Film Studies, our aim is to give all students an insight as to what studying Film Studies is like. We cover a basic level of technique as well as showing how this is applied to movies that students will watch. We cover the history of film, understanding how film has developed over the years. Finally, we look at stereotypes that are used in film and how they have an effect, whether that be positive or negative, on the audience.

Our expectation is that students engage with the tasks that they are given, but to approach these activities with creativity and actually enjoy the subject they will explore.

If students are required to choose a film of their own choice, we ask that all parents and guardians check the suitability of the film and that it is age appropriate for our pupils.

3	Watch the clips given and make notes on the genre you identify, based on the 6 elements of genre grid you completed previously. Watch the clips twice. The first time — enjoy it. Before you watch the film – have a look at the film poster or the cover of the DVD. What stands out to you? What can you see that makes the Genre stand out to you? Task 1

How do we identify Genre?

The six elements of Genre:

- <u>Setting</u> Where is the film set? What time period is the film set in? Is it set in an urban (city) or rural (countryside) environment?
- <u>Themes</u> Are there any themes within the film that you notice? Think about Law & Order, Corruption, Families, Romance, Justice, Teamwork and Relationships.

 There are lots and lots more as well!
- <u>Characters</u> Who are the protagonists (heroes) and antagonists (villains) in the film? Are there any other main characters who don't fit into either category? What would you describe them as?
- <u>Props/Significant Objects</u> Are there any props/costumes that make you instantly think that this is in a certain genre? Why do you think you have this reaction?
- <u>Narrative/Plot</u> What happens in the film? Is it a straightforward film or are there complications in the story? Is there a happy ending?
- <u>Style</u> Can you think of any times when you noticed a type of camera shot or lighting? What effect do you think it had on the audience? Are there any special effects or stunts in the film?

	Expectation of Rom-Com	Example to support ideas	Micro Feature?	Intended Effect?
Setting	Urban (city) as this is where most people live, and can fall in love.			
Themes	Love, Romance, Family, Sacrifice, Self-discovery.			
Characters	At least two single people; perhaps a best friend who helps; family.			
Props/Cost umes	Hearts; rings; cards; phones; costumes that reflect the styles of the time.			
Narrative/Plot	Two single people who cannot find love bump into each other, and fall for each other; happy ending.			
Style	Lots of wide shots of settings; close ups on faces and hands to show emotion.




