Instrumentation	The instruments that are used in a piece
Hit Point	A point in a story which informs the music.
Question & Answer	Two short phrases that respond to each other
Dynamics	How loud or quiet a piece of music is.
Timbre	The type of sound an instrument makes
Pulse	A steady underlying beat
Rhythm	The pattern of long and short notes.
Tempo	How fast or slow a piece of music is.
Structure	The way a piece of music is put together
Texture	How many layers of music there are.
Melody	The main tune in a piece of music.
