

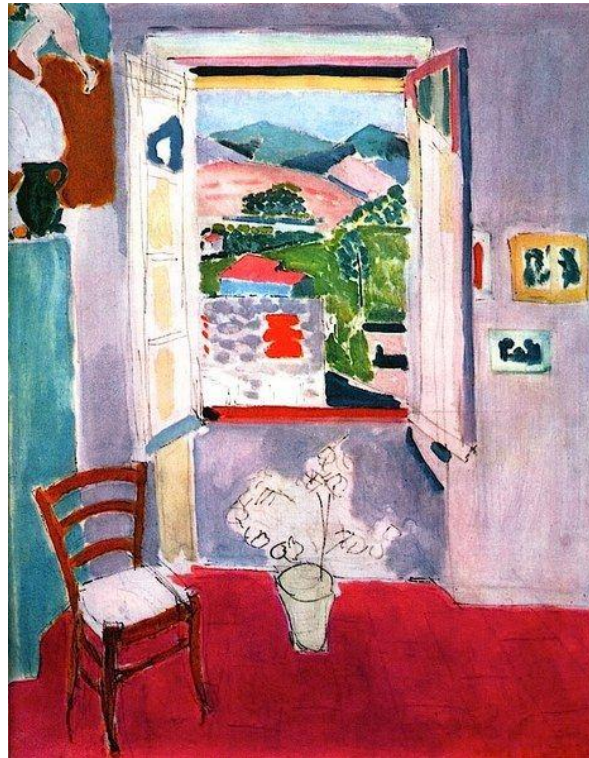

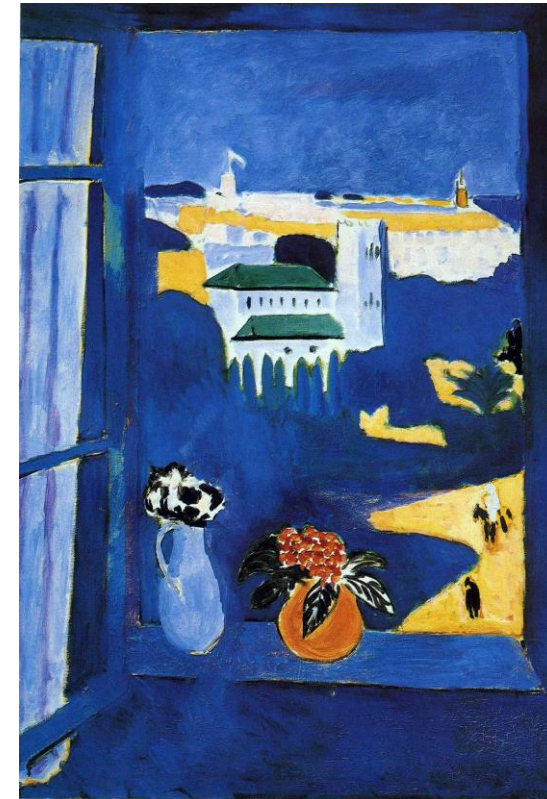
**Look at the work of Henri Matisse.**

**Window at Tangier**

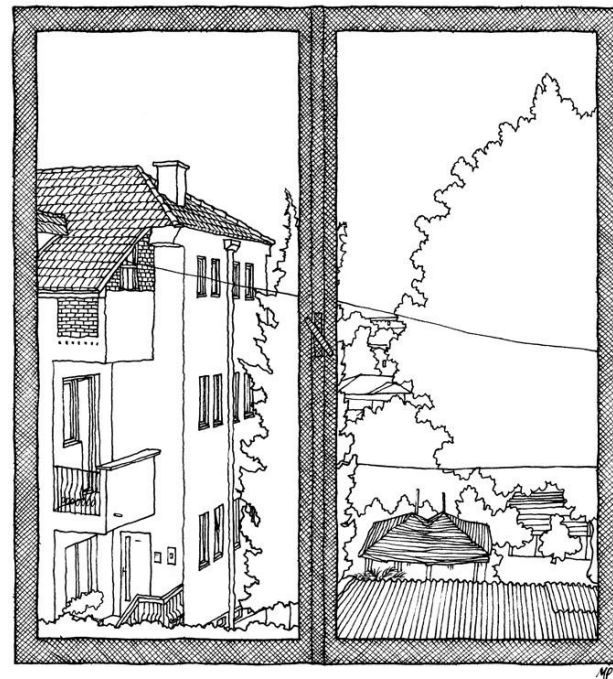
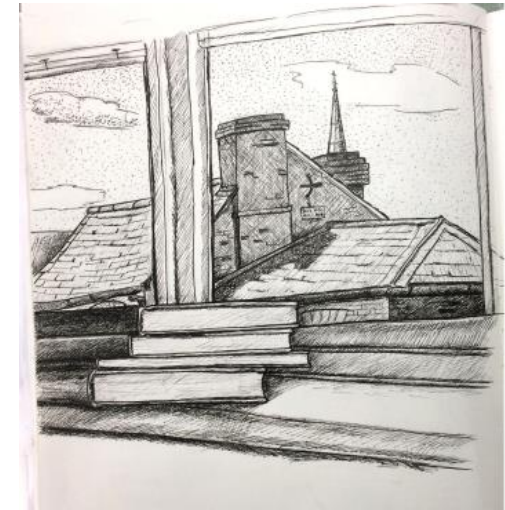
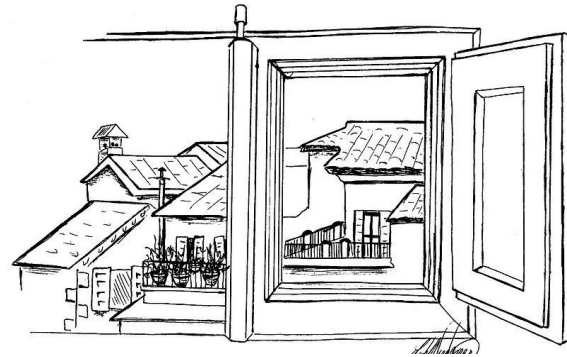


## Task 1
