

Miss Goodbourn's Cultural Challenge

1. Research a French or Spanish speaking artist and create a fact file about them. e.g. Dalí, Picasso or Monet.



2. Recreate your favourite piece of art by the artist you researched.

3. Write a calligram (picture poem) about an animal in French or Spanish.

4. Pick a word in French or Spanish (which is at least 7 letters long) and make an acrostic poem for it.

5. Write a diary entry about what you did yesterday at home using the passé composé or the pretérito.

6. Learn the lyrics to a French or Spanish song using 'lyricstraining'. Try the following:

- Stromae- Papaoutai;
- Bigflo Oli- Dommage;
- Cœur de Pirate- Crier tout bas, Comme des enfants;
- ZAZ - Je veux;
- Mika – Elle me dit;
- Marc Anthony - Vivir mi vida;
- Enrique Iglesias - Bailando, Súbeme la radio, Dímelos;
- Shakira – Waka Waka, La tortura, Suerte.

7. Create your own French or Spanish song to revise the vocab you learnt in Cycles 1-3.

8. Research a famous landmark in a French or Spanish speaking country.



9. Create a piece of artwork or a model of the landmark you researched.



10. Find a French or a Spanish recipe and translate the ingredients and quantities into English. Try:

11. Have a go at making your recipe and write some opinions about it in French or Spanish!.(Subject to having the necessary ingredients!)

12. Research a period of French or Spanish history or a historical figure. e.g. The French revolution of 1789, The Spanish Civil War, Napoleon, Charles de Gaulle.



13. Watch a French or Spanish film/programme on Netflix. e.g.

- Miraculous (Set to French with English Subtitles) (PG);
- Chef's Table France (PG);
- 10 Jours en Or (U);
- Nailed it, France (PG);
- Wakfu (Set to French or Spanish with English subtitles) (12);
- The Road to El Dorado (Set to Spanish with English Subtitles) (U);
- The Tale of Despereaux (Set to either French or Spanish with English subtitles) (U);
- Siempre Bruja (Always a Witch) (12).
- Many English animated programmes can also be set to French or Spanish e.g. Pokémon The Movie.
- Or you could watch a cultural film in English. e.g. Les Misérables.
