## Re: French Language Visit to Paris 2024

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am delighted to inform you that the Modern Foreign Languages Department is organising a trip for the current Year 8 and 9 cohort to Paris, France in July 2024 (5<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup> July). The visit is a language immersion trip, where students will experience excursions and activities in the target language and will be encouraged to use their language skills at every opportunity. Therefore, this visit is suitable for students who are taking GCSE French at KS4 next year, and there will be a limited number of student places. The sample itinerary includes:

- Full board accommodation at Campus Sainte Therèse (or similar);
- Executive coach transport and ferry crossing;
- A dedicated French-native Animateur to lead excursions in French;
- Full programme of free evening entertainment, conducted in French, at the accommodation;
- French language activity workbook per student;
- Pre-booked excursions in Paris, including the Louvre, Tour Montparnasse, a cruise on the River Seine, Arc de Triomphe, the Sacré Cœur Basilica, Stade de France and Parc Astérix (or similar);
- Visits to famous cultural quarters in Paris including the Champs-Élysées and Montmartre (or similar).

The cost will be **approximately £695**, which will cover: all travel, excursions, activities, insurance and full board accommodation. In order to keep costs down, we will be travelling by coach.

In order to provide you with more information regarding this trip a meeting will be held on **Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> June at 18:00** in the **Performance Theatre.** After this meeting has taken place, we require an initial **non-refundable deposit of £125** to be made via Parent Pay between the dates of **23<sup>rd</sup> June and 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2023**. We will then continue collecting payments in monthly instalments of **£65** to be made on 1<sup>st</sup> of every month **starting on 1<sup>st</sup> August 2023**, with the remaining balance due on 1<sup>st</sup> **April 2024**. All payments will need to be made via Parent Pay.

## Re: Spanish Language Visit to Andalucía 2024

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am delighted to inform you that the Modern Foreign Languages Department is organising a trip for the current Year 8 and 9 cohort to the region of Andalucía, Spain in July 2024 (19<sup>th</sup> – 23rd<sup>th</sup> July 2024). The visit is a language immersion trip, where students will experience excursions and activities in the target language and will be encouraged to use their language skills at every opportunity. Therefore, this visit is suitable for students who are taking GCSE Spanish at KS4 next year, and there will be a limited number of student places. The sample itinerary includes:

- Full board accommodation at the Spark Centre, El Puerto (or similar);
- Return flights;
- A dedicated Spanish-native tour guide to lead excursions in Spanish;
- Spanish language sessions with teaching materials;
- A full programme of free evening entertainment, conducted in Spanish, at the accommodation;
- Pre-booked excursions to the Spanish cities of Seville and Cadiz;
- Guided visits of cultural attractions in Seville to the La Giralda Cathedral, the Alcázar Gardens, Plaza España and Barrio de Santa Cruz;
- Visits in Cadiz to Parque Genoves, and Torre Taviera;
- Visits in El Puerto to the bullring, local market, Castillo de San Marcos and the beach;
- Evening meal out at a Tapas restaurant;
- Churros and chocolate tasting;
- Spanish cooking class.

The cost will be **approximately £895**, which will cover: all travel, excursions, activities, insurance and full-board accommodation.
