It is important to know that every Parents' Evening is different; there will always be new and important information communicated, which will enable you to better support your child's Independent Learning and their progress in the Academy at home. Attendance at the previous one was excellent; I hope we can continue that trend this time.

The main aims of this meeting will be:

- To receive your child's Interim Report 2;
- To discuss progress to date;
- · To identify areas for further development or 'next steps', as we move through the year in that particular Core subject area;
- Receipt of a Diagnostic Report on your child's current Reading Age and strategies for improvement;
- Parent/Carer Reflection on your child's work;
- To discuss your child's target grades for this academic year and as s/he progresses through the Academy until Year 11.



You will not be able to speak to your child's Innov8 Learning Consultant(s) or Tutor. We recommend that students are present at these meetings, though should you wish to meet without them, that can be arranged.

You can book to see the Learning Consultant who teaches your child during Period 3 on a Monday. At each subsequent Parents' Evening event, you will rotate around the subjects until the end of the academic year; this means you will have the opportunity to visit all five Core subject areas and their respective Learning Consultants.
