**Re: Severe Weather Emergency Closure**

Dear Parents and Carers,

As the winter approaches, it is necessary to consider that there may be a time when the Academy is forced to close. In the event of an Academy closure, a notice will be published on the Academy website and Facebook page. Local radio stations and Sandwell Local Authority will also be notified so that they can in turn share a list of school closures via their platforms.

There will be no lesson provision on the first day of any Q3 Academy Langley closure. However, should the closure be extended to more than one day, a blended learning approach will be provided from day two.

Each day that the Academy remains closed, students will have access to all PDF lessons on the Independent Learning area of the Academy website. In addition, there will be live lessons that will take place at the following times if staff are able to deliver them remotely.

Lesson 1: 08:45 – 09:15


Lesson 2: 10:45 – 11:15

Lesson 3: 13:30 – 14:00

These lessons will be shorter than the usual 100 minutes with students expected to work independently offline. All remote lessons will take place via Microsoft Teams. Students have been issued with their new Teams and Langley email log-ins. It is the responsibility of the student to ensure that they have access to their accounts. If they do not, they must raise this with their Tutor by the end of the Autumn Term (Friday 15<sup>th</sup> December).
