All AOs were tested in line with the GCSE assessment criteria.	Medium - the assessment was completed under strict exam conditions but students in different groups took the assessment at different times, classwork and homework done in low-level/ unsupervised conditions. Students with access arrangements were given the required arrangements including readers, scribes, extra time, coloured paper and laptop use.
February 2020 – Year 10 Cycle 2.	Influences on Business – written assessment containing Eduqas exam questions.	AO1, 2, 3, 4.	The assessments covered some topics which were taught in year 9 and revisited in year 10, these were wider external factors influencing business decisions. The writing assessment was taken from past papers published by the exam board. All AOs were tested in line with the GCSE assessment criteria.	Medium - both assessments were completed under strict exam conditions but students in different groups took the assessment at different times, classwork and homework done in low-level/ unsupervised conditions. Gabriel Potter was given 25% extra time.
October 2020 – Year 11 Cycle 1.	Marketing and Finance written assessment containing Eduqas exam questions.	AO1, 2, 3, 4.	The assessments covered new topics including marketing and finance. This tested students understanding of numerical formulae and included questions taken from past papers. All AOs were tested in line with the GCSE assessment criteria.	Medium - the assessment was completed under strict exam conditions but students in different groups took the assessment at different times, classwork and homework done in low-level/ unsupervised conditions. Students with access arrangements were given the required arrangements including readers, scribes, extra time, coloured paper and laptop use.
