A is incorrect because it says daughter.

C is incorrect because it says “hijos” in plural.

D is incorrect because “mis” is plural.

A is incorrect because “aceptar” is an infinitive verb.

B is incorrect because it hasn't included the “me” and “aceptar is infinitive.

D is incorrect because it says “friends” in plural.

B is incorrect because it says ‘hermana’ which is sister.

C is incorrect because it says ‘hermanos’ in plural.

D is incorrect because it says “tendría” which means I would have.
