<p><b>The cycle of lessons is taught on a four-cycle rotation.</b></p>	<p><b>What is entrepreneurship?</b></p>	<p>This content allows students to begin understanding the fundamentals of Business.</p> <p>Students will be exploring project based learning in collaboration with Computer Science and Design Technology to create a Multifunctional Desk Organiser which can be marketed and sold to a customer.</p> <p>In addition, through use of case studies, students will begin to apply new knowledge to real business scenarios allowing them to grapple with key concepts.</p> <p>Students will develop specific skills in the following areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Team Worker</li> <li>- Effective Participants</li> <li>- Independent Enquirers</li> <li>- Self-Managers</li> <li>- Creative Thinkers</li> <li>- Reflective Learners</li> <li>- Entrepreneurial Skills</li> </ul>	<p>To include: Entrepreneurial skills, characteristics and qualities. Followed by a comparison of iconic entrepreneurs whose skills have supported their business models.</p> <p>This will then progress into business aims, objectives and mission statements. Students will begin to link this to business size by examining multinational companies and how they operate.</p> <p>Students will explore a range of business topics which later on link with GCSE and BTEC</p> <p>Year 7 will finalise this cycle by creating their own Multifunctional Desk Organiser which links together all content covered, this will help to develop key skills for later years of business study including: AO1 (knowledge), AO2 (application) and AO3 (analysis and evaluation) where they will critically think and reflect on their own ideas.</p>
