

Provider Access Policy

Introduction

This policy statement sets out the Academy's arrangements for managing the access of providers to students at the Academy for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Student Entitlement

All students in years 7-11 are entitled:

- To find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point;
- To hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships – through options events, assemblies and group discussions, and taster events;
- To understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

Management of Provider Access Requests

A provider wishing to request access should contact Grace Cox/Sharmaine Perrin responsible for information, advice and guidance.

Q3 Langley will make the Performance Theatre, classrooms and other meeting rooms available for discussions between providers and students, as appropriate to the activity. The Academy will also make available specialist equipment, where available, to support provider presentations. This will all be discussed and agreed in advance of the visit with the Careers Leader.

Providers are welcome to leave a copy of their prospectus or other relevant course literature with the Careers Leader.

Opportunities for Access

At Q3 Langley, a number of events, integrated into the careers programme, will offer providers an opportunity to come into the Academy to speak to students and parents/carers. Please speak to Sharmaine Perrin to identify the most suitable opportunity for you. Q3 Academies Trust's policy on safeguarding sets out the Academy approach to allowing providers into the Academy as visitors to talk to our students.
