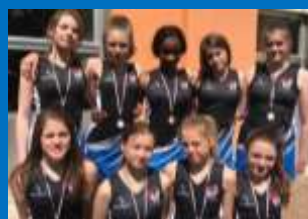

Option 2 - One payment:

By October 30th 2023.

Selection Process



- First priority: students who have represented the academy in sports fixtures with excellent behaviour.
- Second priority: students who have attended sports clubs with excellent behaviour.
- Remaining places: selected at random.

Reserve:

Any students not selected will be placed on the reserve list. Should a reserve student be required to fill a place, random selection will be made.

- Have a choice of residential centres on offer.

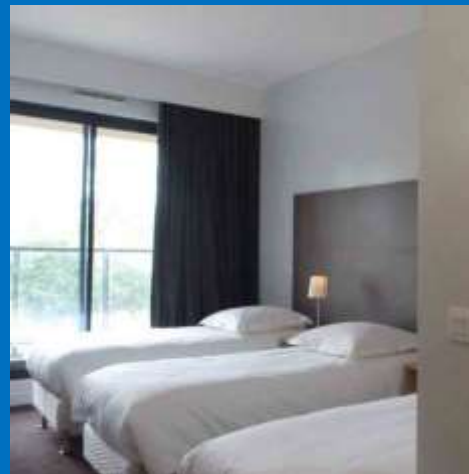


Campus Sainte Thèrese

- French speaking animateurs lead French language activities each evening;
- The campus has lots of outside space available for activities and games.

Spark Residential Centre

El Puerto de Santa Maria, Cádiz

- This centre is the preferred partner of Voyager School Travel for Paris trips;
- 15 minute walk from Cádiz town centre and beach;
- English is not widely spoken here;
- Situated nearby to several Spanish cities including Seville, Granada, Ronda and Malaga.
- Hosts school groups exclusively;
- Spanish speakers lead evening activities in Spanish;
- The campus has lots of chill out areas, such as a rooftop terrace.

Important Information!



Excursions and evening activities will all be conducted in the target language for an immersive language and cultural experience.

This trip will be most suited for students on Pathway 1 or 2 who are going to be taking French or Spanish at KS4 (current Y9s), or those students likely to be taking languages at KS4 (current Y8s).

Please consider other trips instead if you do not enjoy languages.



Paris - What is included?

- Full board accommodation at Campus Sainte Therèse;
- Executive coach transport and ferry crossing;
- A dedicated French-native Animateur to lead excursions in French;
- Full programme of free evening entertainment, conducted in French, at the accommodation;
- French language activity workbook per student;
- Pre-booked excursions in Paris, including the Louvre, Tour Montparnasse, a cruise on the River Seine, Arc de Triomphe, the Sacré Cœur Basilica, Stade de France (or similar);
- Day at Parc Astérix;
- Visits to famous cultural quarters in Paris including the Champs-Élysées and Montmartre (or similar).

Andalucía - What is included?

- Full board accommodation at the Spark Centre, El Puerto (or similar);
- Return flights;
- A dedicated Spanish-native tour guide to lead excursions in Spanish;
- Spanish language sessions with teaching materials;
- A full programme of free evening entertainment, conducted in Spanish, at the accommodation;
- Pre-booked excursions to the Spanish cities of Seville and Cadiz;
- Guided visits of cultural attractions in Seville to the La Giralda Cathedral, the Alcázar Gardens, Plaza España and Barrio de Santa Cruz;
- Visits in Cadiz to Parque Genoves, and Torre Taviera;
- Visits in El Puerto to the bullring, local market, Castillo de San Marcos and the beach;
- Evening meal out at a Tapas restaurant;
- Churros and chocolate tasting and a Spanish cooking class.

After selection, the initial £125 deposit is non-refundable under any circumstances.

If your child voluntarily withdraws or is removed due to poor behaviour, any monies paid **after** the initial £125 deposit will not be refunded unless your child's place is filled and paid for by another student.

Option 1 – Instalments 1st of every month:

8 x £65pcm payments

1 x £50 payment

Starting from August 2023, last payment April 2024.

Option 2 – One payment:

1 x £570 payment

By October 30th 2023.

Refunds

After selection, the initial £250 deposit is non-refundable under any circumstances.

If your child voluntarily withdraws or is removed due to poor behaviour, any monies paid **after** the initial £250 deposit will not be refunded unless your child's place is filled and paid for by another student.

Option 1 – Instalments 1st of every month:

3 x £75pcm payments on 1st August, September and October.

7 x £60 from 1st November with the last payment 1st April 2024.

Option 2 – Two payments

£150 by 1st September 2023

Final payment of £495 due by 15th December 2023.

Selection Process



- First priority: students who are taking languages at KS4 (current Y9s).
- Second priority: Students likely to be taking language at KS4 (current Y8s).
- Remaining places: selected at random.

Reserve:

Any students not selected will be placed on the reserve list. Should a reserve student be required to fill a place, random selection will be made.

Other considerations:

- Family lunch debt;
- Behaviour.

Next Steps



If you wish for your child to attend the trip please follow these steps:

Step 1: pay the deposit via parent pay between 23rd and 30th June for the Venice trip (by 3rd July) for the MFL trips.

Step 2: your child will receive a letter to highlight whether they have/have not been successful in gaining a place.

Step 3: if your child does gain a place, complete the reply slip that will be attached to their letter.

If your child does not gain a place, the Academy will refund your initial deposit. You will be notified of this via a letter.
