Re: Year 11 Mock Examination Weeks

Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 11 students will be undertaking their second set of mock examinations from **Monday 7**th **March until Thursday 17**th **March.** Students must ensure they arrive on time, have all their equipment, and their personalised examination timetable.

It is vitally important that all Year 11 students sit all mock examinations, as this may be the basis of Teacher Assessed Grades if the summer 2022 exam series is cancelled, as occurred in May-June 2021. In addition, references for college, sixth form and apprenticeships will include mock examination results. The government are planning for exams to take place this summer, but with Covid-19, those plans may be forced to change.

Students must arrive at the Academy by 08:20 each day, and will leave at 15:30. Please note that no additional revision sessions or interventions will be taking place during the mock examination weeks. Students must bring with them their normal equipment: two black pens, two pencils, a 30cm ruler, rubber, scientific calculator and optional highlighter pens in a clear pencil case.

On Friday 18th March, students that have missed any mock examinations will need to come into the Academy to complete those missing assessments. All other Year 11 students will work from home and access remote learning on a wide range of RSHE information. Year 11 students are required to email their Tutor by 09:30 on this day to demonstrate they have engaged with the material on the Academy website.
