## Re: Year 9 History Trip to Belgium Battlefields

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of the Key Stage 3 Year 9 History Curriculum, we are really looking forward to taking 45 Year 9 students to the World War One Battlefields of Northern France and Belgium in June 2024. This trip contributes significantly to student understanding of curriculum content, including the conditions, the strategic importance of trenches, and the weapons used in the First World War. Although Pathways choices will not have been made by students when this trip takes place, place priority may be given based on those students who have an interest in pursuing History at GCSE. On top of this, attendance and behaviour will also be taken into account when selecting students.

The sample itinerary includes:

- Full board accommodation
- Visit to Flanders Field Museum and Passchendaele Museum
- Visit to a trench system
- Visit to Langemark Cemetery and Thiepval Memorial
- Visit to the site of the Battle of the Somme
- Attending the Last Post Ceremony at Menin Gate
- Full evening entertainment in the hotel, including ten pin bowling

The trip will commence early morning on Wednesday  $26^{\text{th}}$  June 2024 and students will return late in the evening on Friday  $28^{\text{th}}$  June.

## The details of the proposed trip are as follows:

When: Wednesday 26th June - Friday 28th June 2024

Deposit: Deposit to be paid no later than 29th September 2023 (this is required to secure a

place and is non-refundable if your child is allocated a place).

Contribution: Total cost of the trip is £257. A £60 deposit must be provided to secure a place on

the trip – this is non-refundable. If you feel there are circumstances in which you are entitled to financial assistance from Q3 Langley, and would like your child to go on the trip, then please make contact with Mr. Dale/Mr. Gee to discuss this

further.
