Instrumental Tuition Fees Payments for 2026-27

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted that your child has been offered a place for instrumental music tuition during the 2026-27 academic year. We look forward to supporting them on their musical journey and helping them develop their musical skills, confidence and enjoyment of music.

Regular instrumental lessons provide students with valuable opportunities to develop discipline, creativity and resilience, while also giving them the chance to experience the enjoyment and achievement that comes from learning an instrument.

The cost of tuition is:

- **£70 per term**
- **£35 per term for students eligible for Pupil Premium**

This represents excellent value for specialist instrumental tuition. Where required, the fee also includes the loan of a school instrument, meaning there is no need for families to purchase equipment separately.

Home School Agreement

Enclosed with this letter is a **Home School Agreement** for instrumental tuition. This document outlines the terms and conditions of the tuition programme, including expectations regarding attendance, commitment to practice, payments and the care of any loaned instruments.

The signed agreement must be returned for your child's place in the tuition programme to be confirmed and lessons to commence.

Payment Information

To enable us to continue providing high-quality tuition and to keep administration to a minimum, payments must be made within the designated two-week payment window each term.

Autumn Term Payment Window: 21/09/26 - 02/10/26

Spring Term Payment Window: 18/01/27 - 29/01/27

Summer Term Payment Window: 26/04/27 - 07/05/27

Payments are due in advance for each term's lessons.

We kindly ask that payments are made within these windows. If payment has not been received by the closing date, we will contact you regarding the outstanding balance. Continued non-payment may result in overdue payment reminders being issued and, where appropriate, lessons being suspended or your child's tuition place being withdrawn until the account is brought up to date.

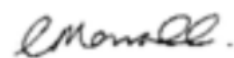
Instrument Loans
